## RUNNING the DEFENSIVE HANDGUN

This is a physically intensive one day course, with a 2 day option, that covers all of the essential skills involved in fighting with a modern duty / concealed carry handgun. Class will last all day, 9:00am to 6:00pm. Students will be challenged with progressively demanding drills.

- **Force on Force exercises**
- **Lethal Force continuum**
- **Rapid presentation from carry**
- **Effective gun handling techniques**
- **Rapid reloading techniques**

- **Defensive mindset**

Expect to fire about 400-600 rounds of ammunition. This course is designed expressly for the law enforcement professional or armed citizen that is looking to advance and maintain existing handgun skills as well as exercising cognitive process while diagnosing shooting problems.

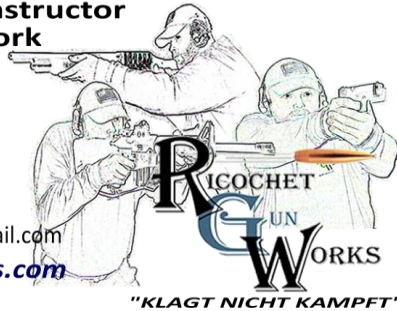
You will need a quality, revolver or semiauto handgun, a quality handgun model specific belt holster (no generic fit nylon holsters... please call with questions). I require a belt holster as the primary holster for all range work, but other types (ie shoulder, ankle, tactical drop) will be covered and you are encouraged to bring them if you carry with them. Duty rigs highly encouraged. (Vests and plate carriers are welcome, but not required). At least three magazines, (more is helpful). A magazine pouch, a ball cap, eye and ear protection, and rain gear (we train rain or shine). A cooler with soft drinks, snacks and lunch is a very good idea.

Please bring good quality ammunition. You will shoot better, your gun will function better, and you will learn faster.

Your primary instructor will be Paul Hamers, owner, **RICOCHET GUN WORKS**. Tuition is 1 Day \$200, 2 Day \$300.
